INSTRUCTION TO CANDIDATES

The Sixteenth Convocation of the Board for conferring Post Graduate and Post Doctoral qualifications on successful candidates of the DNB Examinations of December 2008 & June, 2009 sessions / FNB Exit examinations of the year 2008 will be held on **Monday, the 5th of April, 2010 at Vigyan Bhawan, Maulana Azad Marg, New Delhi-110011.**

1. Candidates eligible for award of the above qualifications only will be admitted in person at the convocation.

Applications for admission to the above qualification 'in person' or 'in-absentia' in the form enclosed should be forwarded to Dr. A.K. Sood, Executive Director, National Board of Examinations, Ansari Nagar, New Delhi-110029, so as to reach this office on or before 26th of March' 2010. The applications should be accompanied by a passport size photograph of the candidate duly attested.

Envelope bearing Application form is to be super-scribed as "16th CONVOCATION".

Candidates desirous of being admitted 'in-absentia' should clearly state the same in their application forms. Kindly note that in-absentia degrees will be dispatched to the candidates only after three months from the date of Convocation.

2. **ENROLMENT FEES**

All candidates who have qualified the DNB Examinations are to submit the mandatory Enrolment Fees of Rs. 1000/- for receipt of their DNB Degrees. Only those candidates who have remitted their Enrolment fees shall be conferred their Degrees 'in person' during the Convocation. Therefore, **candidates who have not paid their Enrolment fees so far, are to submit the same through a Demand Draft of Rs. 1000/- favouring National Board of Examinations, New Delhi, along with their application forms.**

3. **DEGREE IN-ABSENTIA**

Candidates who are unable to attend the convocation, should apply for their Degrees 'in-absentia' in the accompanied form along with a passport size attested photograph and a D.D. for Rs. 1000/- only, drawn in favour of National Board of Examinations, New Delhi. Kindly note that the degrees will be dispatched to the candidates only after three months from the date of Convocation.

Please note that this 'in-absentia' fees of Rs. 1000/- is in addition to the Enrollment fee of Rs. 1000/- which is required to be paid by every DNB passed candidate.

4. **THESIS PENDING CASES**

Only those candidates whose Thesis have been approved shall be admitted to the Convocation and receive their Degrees 'in person' during the Convocation. Candidates whose Thesis is still pending approval of the Board shall be awarded their degree 'In-absentia' only after their Thesis is approved.

5. **IDENTITY-CUM-RECEIPT SLIP**

The Identity-cum-Receipt Slip duly filled in with the candidate's photograph and specimen signatures should be returned along with the Convocation application form so as to reach this office on or before 26th of March' 2010.

6. **REPORTING TIME**

All candidates desirous of receiving their Degrees 'in person' during the Convocation should report sharp at 0900 hrs at the Atrium of Vigyan Bhawan, Maulana Azad Marg, New Delhi-110011 on the 5th of April' 2010.

Each candidate should obtain from the Designated Officer of the Board, an Identity Slip to enable his / her admission into the Convocation Hall.

7. **REHERSAL**

There will be a dress rehearsal on the 5th April' 2010 in the Vigyan Bhawan, Maulana Azad Marg, New Delhi-110011. All candidates should attend the rehearsal to facilitate orderly conduct of Convocation. The candidates for admission to the Degree in person must be present at the rehearsal where there will be a roll call. They must remain in their seats in the convocation hall till the rehearsal is over.

No one will be admitted to the hall after the final roll is called.

8. **SEATING ARRANGEMENTS IN THE CONVOCATION HALL**

Candidates who are present in the Convocation 'in person' will be allotted a seat and a list showing the seat numbers allotted to them will be displayed outside the Convocation hall.

9. **ACADEMIC COSTUMES**

The candidates shall wear the prescribed Convocation Gown, which will be available at the premises of convocation, on payment basis on the 5th of April' 2010 prior to the rehearsal.

10. **CONVOCATION DRESS**

Male candidates should appear in High-buttoned-up-coats with Trousers (National Dress) or Trousers with Coat and Necktie, while Female candidates should wear Sarees with Blouse; or Shirt with Salwar or Chooridar / Pyjamas.

11. **STAY & TRAVEL**

Candidates will have to make their own arrangements for their travel and stay at New Delhi. National Board of Examinations will not be able to make such arrangements for the candidates or their friends / family members.

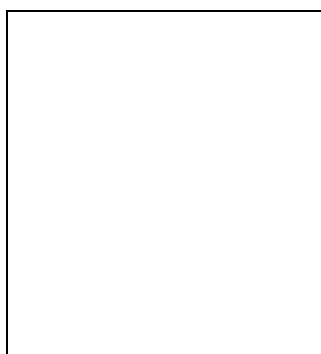
