#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The Government of India established the National Board of Examinations (NBE) in 1975 with the objective of improving the quality of the Medical Education by establishing high and uniform standards of postgraduate examinations in modern medicine on an all India basis and utilizing existing infrastructure for capacity building.

NBE at present conducts postgraduate and postdoctoral examinations in approved specialties leading to the award of Diplomate of National Board. The Medical Council of India has laid down standards for postgraduate examinations conducted by various medical colleges and affiliated to concerned universities and other institutions, yet the levels of proficiency and standards of evaluation vary considerably in these institutions.

The Examinations conducted by NBE provide a common standard and mechanism of evaluation of minimum level of attainment of the knowledge and competencies for which postgraduate courses were started in medical institutions. Moreover, intra country and international comparisons are facilitated with the availability of commonly accepted evaluation mechanism.

#### RECOGNITION OF DNB QUALIFICATIONS

The Nomenclature of the qualification awarded by the National Board of Examinations is "**Diplomate of National Board**". The list of recognized qualifications awarded by the Board in various Broad and Super specialties as approved by the Government of India and included in the First Schedule of IMC Act 1956 is as at **Annexure 1**.

As per the Indian Medical Council Act 1956; the power to recognize medical qualification and determine their equivalence rests with central government.

The Diplomate qualifications awarded by the National Board of Examinations are equated with the postgraduate and post doctorate degrees awarded by other Indian Universities for all purposes including appointment to teaching posts as lecture/Assistant Professor by the Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare; vide their notifications issued from time to time.

The holders of Board's qualification awarded after an examination i.e. DNB are eligible to be considered for specialist's post/faculty in any Hospital including a training/teaching institution on a teaching post/ as faculty member.

Diplomate National Board qualifications are well recognized and accepted globally.



## 2. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANT CANDIDATES:

- 2.1. DNB CET is the entrance examination for admission to the 3 years postgraduate DNB programme including Direct 6 years courses in the specialty of Plastic Surgery, Neuro-Surgery, Cardio-thoracic Surgery and Pediatric Surgery. The examinations are held as per the schedule of examinations prescribed by the NBE from time to time.
- 2.2. Online Applications for the examination must be completed by the prescribed cutoff date. Candidate will be able to print the acknowledgment of submission of online application on successful completion of their online application.
- 2.3. Applications of candidates producing false or fabricated information will not be considered and candidates may be further debarred from appearing in any future examinations conducted by NBE.
- 2.4. Candidates should go through the bulletin carefully for eligibility criteria, scheme, pattern of examination etc before contacting the NBE Office for any queries. Queries pertaining to eligibility and other issues will only be entertained if the information requested is not given in bulletin or on website www.natboard.edu.in
- 2.5. Incomplete applications or applications not in accordance with instructions will not be considered and are liable to be rejected. The examination fee will not be refunded in such cases.
- 2.6. Fee will neither be carried forward to a future date nor refunded under any circumstances. Online applications and/or their acknowledgment of submission received after the due date will not be entertained and exam fee will not be returned in such cases. Application once submitted cannot be withdrawn.
- 2.7. Candidates found to be ineligible at any stage of CET will not be permitted to appear in the examination. In an unlikely event of any ineligible candidate appearing and/or being successful in the CET, the results/candidature of such candidate shall be cancelled and/or are deemed to be cancelled.
- 2.8. Instructions in the information-bulletin are liable to changes based on decisions taken by the Board from time to time. There is no equity or any rights that are /or deemed to be arising in favor of candidate.



- 2.9. NBE reserves the right to withdraw permission, if any, granted inadvertently to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in the CET even though the admit card/roll number has been issued or name/roll number is displayed on the website of the Board.
- 2.10. Candidates' eligibility is purely provisional & is subject to the fulfillment of eligibility criteria as prescribed by the Board.
- 2.11. NBE reserves its absolute rights to alter the examination schedule, pattern policy and guidelines at any time during the continuation or after the completion of DNB training (3 or 6 years as the case may be.) The candidate shall have no right whatsoever for claiming/deriving any right from past or present schedule, policy and guidelines of NBE.
- 2.12. The existing schedule, pattern, policy and guidelines are for ready reference only but in no way they are or are ought to be treated as representative or acknowledgment of fact that NBE is bound to follow the same in future.
- 2.13. In case of any ambiguity in interpretation of any of the instructions/ terms/rules/criteria regarding the determination of eligibility/conduct of examinations/registration of candidates/information contained herein, the interpretation of the National Board of Examinations will be final and binding.
- 2.14 Requests are not entertained for change in date/ examination centre.
- 2.15. Absentees from the examination will forfeit their examination fee.
- 2.16 Result and roll number for CET may also be seen on the website www.natboard.edu.in
- 2.17 In addition to their admit card, candidates are required to carry one of the following Government issued (original) photo IDs -

Passport or

PAN Card or

Voters' ID card or

Aadhaar Card

Kindly note no Photo copies will be allowed.

The examination test centre staff on duty are authorized to verify the identity of candidates and may take steps to verify and record the identity of candidates. Candidates are required to extend requisite cooperation. In case the candidates does not posses any of these above mentioned ID Cards he/she may contact NBE office atleast 2 weeks prior to the commencement of exam.



- 2.18 All Payments are to be made by cash through Bank Challan in favour of National Board of Examinations at designated branches of Indian Bank / Axis Bank.
- 2.19. Candidates should ensure before applying for the registration that their MBBS degree is recognized as per provisions of Indian Medical Council Act. If it is found at any time that MBBS degree is not recognized, the candidature/result shall be cancelled/deemed to be cancelled.
- 2.20. All the correspondence should be addressed to the Executive Director, National Board of Examinations, Mahatma Gandhi Marg, Ansari Nagar, New Delhi-110029. Candidates are requested to kindly super scribe the envelope with Subject matter of the correspondence for expeditious processing.
- 2.21. Terms & Conditions of the CET as mentioned in the English version of information bulletin shall apply.
- 2.22. The CET shall be conducted by NBE at exam centres engaged for the purpose, keeping in view the constraints of capacity, the centre shall be allocated appropriately.
- 2.23 The jurisdiction for court cases/disputes shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of competent courts at Delhi/New Delhi only.



# 3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR CET - JULY 2012 ADMISSION SESSION

- (I) Candidates who are in possession of MBBS degree/Provisional Pass Certificate recognized as per the provisions of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956 and possess permanent / provisional registration certificate of MBBS qualification issued by the Medical Council of India and have completed one year of internship/likely to complete on or before 30<sup>th</sup> June 2012 may apply for CET through online application.
- (ii) Candidates found to be ineligible at any stage of CET will not be permitted to appear in the examination. In an unlikely event of any ineligible candidate appearing and/or being successful in the CET, the results/candidature of such candidate shall be cancelled and/or are deemed to be cancelled.
- (iii) Requests for appearing in CET from candidates completing internship after 30<sup>th</sup> June 2012 shall be summarily rejected.
- (iv) Candidates already pursuing a MD/MS or DNB course are not eligible to appear for the CET till such time they have completed the duration of prescribed course or have been discharged from the course. (w.e.f. DNB-CET December 2012)



#### 4. EXAMINATION FEE:

- i) CET Exam **Rs. 3500/-**
- ii) Application Form fees Rs. 750/-

#### **Deposition of Fees:**

Fee can be paid only by way of Bank Challan/pay-in-slip through Cash Deposit at any branch of Indian Bank (website: www.indianbank.in) or Axis Bank (website: www.axisbank.com).

Kindly use the specialized pay-in-slip provided along with this Information Bulletin for this purpose. Pay-in-slip can also be downloaded from NBE Website <a href="www.natboard.edu.in">www.natboard.edu.in</a>. NBE copy of pay-in-slip is required to be submitted in original along with acknowledgment for online form submission.

Banks are permitted to levy transaction charges for the above as follows:

Indian Bank - Rs. 30/- per Challan

Axis Bank - Rs. 70/- per Challan

Fees by any other means than specified above shall not be accepted.

Candidates remaining absent from the examination will forfeit their examination fee. Candidates are advised to read the rule position carefully and satisfy the terms and conditions for fulfillment of eligibility criteria.

#### 5. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:

#### **CENTRALISED ENTRANCE TEST (CET)**

- (I) DNB CET is an entrance examination and is an essential pre-requisite for entry to DNB Broad Specialty and Post MBBS Direct 6 years super specialty courses. The next session of entrance examination shall be held in August 2012 and conducted as computer-based test only.
- (ii) Candidates successful in the CET are required to participate in a Centralized merit based counseling conducted by National Board of Examinations for allotment of DNB seats at NBE accredited Institutions/hospitals/medical colleges in order of their merit and candidate shall be able to opt for the NBE accredited institution/hospital/medical college of their choice as per availability at their merit.
- (iii) The provisional list of National Board of Examinations accredited institutes where candidates can pursue DNB is available at NBE website <a href="https://www.natboard.edu.in">www.natboard.edu.in</a> and also enclosed at SI No. 12 of this Bulletin.
- (iv) The examination shall be a multiple choice questions test delivered using computer network as per scheme prescribed.
- (v) Kindly note that the weightage of MCQ's is indicative and purely provisional. NBE reserves its rights to alter /vary /amend the same.
- (vi) **Negative Marking**: 10% i.e. 0.1 mark shall be deducted for every incorrect response.
- (vii) Allocation of time for the DNB CET shall be as follows:

#### 6. SCHEDULE OF EXAMINATION:

- (i) The examination shall be conducted from 9<sup>th</sup> 17<sup>th</sup> August 2012, which is referred to as the examination window.
- (ii) The candidates shall be informed about their exact date, centre and session of examination through admit cards and this information shall also be available on NBE website <a href="https://www.natboard.edu.in">www.natboard.edu.in</a>
- (iii) Candidates may note that each candidate will be required to appear only in the session allocated i.e. either Forenoon or Afternoon on the particular date.

The candidate shall appear at the centre allocated by the National Board at his/her own cost. The Board also reserves the right to allocate centre to the candidates for appearing in the examination at any city across the country.

#### 8. RESULTS

#### (i) QUALIFYING CRITERIA-

Candidates who obtain a minimum score as per category below shall be declared as "Qualified" in DNB CET and issued a PASS/QUALIFYING Certificate.

- a. General Category 50% score
- b. SC/ST/OBC 40% score
- c. Persons with Disability 45% score

#### (ii) VALIDITY OF CET RESULT

The validity of the result of the CET shall be only for the current admission session only i.e. July 2012 session only and cannot be carried forward for the next session of CET.

#### (iii) **DECLARATION OF RESULT**

The results for DNB CET shall be declared in a period of six weeks from conduct of CET.

#### (iv) **DISPATCH OF RESULT**

The result will be sent to the successful candidates individually by post and can also be seen on NBE website.

#### (v) TIE-BREAKER CRITERIA

In the event of two or more candidates obtaining same marks, the merit position shall be determined by the number of wrong responses of such candidates. Candidate with less number of wrong responses shall be placed at higher merit.

In case of tie with same marks and same number of wrong responses, date of birth shall be considered to determine inter-se-merit. An elder candidate shall be placed at a higher merit.



#### 9. INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING APPLICATION FORM

- (I) The application form for CET for admission to DNB courses for July 2012 session is available online on NBE website www.natboard.edu.in
- (ii) Candidate may note that there is no option for submitting the form other than the online mode.
- (iii) Candidates are required to go through the instructions given and overview of the application before proceeding to fill up the online application. Candidates will be allotted an application ID once they accept the NBE terms and conditions and proceed to next step. With this application ID they will be able to access their application in case they fail to complete the same in one session. While submitting online application they will be asked to upload their scanned photograph and signatures. Candidates are advised to keep the ORIGINAL documents pertaining to MBBS qualification ready for successful submission of application.
- (iv) **Photograph -** Upload photograph in JPEG format in the online application. Picture size must be between 20 KB to 100 KB.
- (v) **Signatures** -Upload photograph in JPEG format in the online application. Picture size must be between 10 KB to 50 KB.
- (vi) Online Applications for admission to the examination should be completed by the prescribed cutoff date. Candidates will be able to print the acknowledgment of submission of online application on successful completion of online application. All fields marked \* are mandatory.
- (vii) Documents uploaded by the candidate while submitting online application shall be scanned copies of original documents only. Scanned copies of photocopies of documents will not be accepted.
- (viii) Applications of candidates producing false or fabricated information will not be considered and candidates may be further debarred from appearing in any future examinations.
- (ix) Information bulletin for CET can be downloaded from NBE website <a href="https://www.natboard.edu.in.">www.natboard.edu.in.</a> A copy of the same will also be sent to the candidate on receipt of online application. Candidates should go through the bulletin carefully for eligibility criteria before contacting the Board's Office. Queries pertaining to eligibility and other issues will only be entertained if the information requested is not given in bulletin or on website www.natboard.edu.in.



- (x) Certified copies of following documents are to be submitted along with NBE copy of Online application acknowledgment.
- a MBBS Degree/Provisional Pass Certificate\* \* Provisional certificate of MBBS Degree is permissible only for those candidates who had passed in the MBBS course in the year 2011.
  - If passed MBBS before 2011 and the MBBS degree certificate has not been issued so far by the concerned university, documentary evidence of this in form of a letter from competent authority of respective university to be furnished the time of counseling.
- b Permanent/Provisional Registration certificate\* issued by MCI/State Medical Council for registration of MBBS qualification.
  - \* Permanent Registration certificate issued by MCI/State Medical Council for registration of MBBS qualification is required to be produced by all candidates appearing in the counselling.
- c Original challan duly stamped by Bank as Receipt of Payment.
- (xi) Candidate successfully submitting the form online will be provided with the acknowledgement for online application.
  - Candidates are required to furnish self attested/certified photocopies of documents mentioned as under along with the acknowledgment for successful online form submission.
- a Self Attested/Certified photocopies of MBBS Degree/Provisional Pass Certificate.
- b Self Attested/Certified photocopies of Permanent/Provisional Registration certificate\* issued by MCI/State Medical Council for registration of MBBS qualification
- c Original challan duly stamped by Bank as Receipt of Payment.

#### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR CET – JULY 2012 ADMISSION SESSION

Candidates who are in possession of MBBS degree/Provisional Pass Certificate recognized as per the provisions of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956 and possess permanent / provisional registration certificate of MBBS qualification issued by the Medical Council of India/ State Medical Council and have completed one year of internship/likely to complete on or before 30<sup>th</sup> June 2012 may apply for CET examination through online application.



#### 10. CAUTION NOTICE

- (I) Admission to the DNB course will be done only through Centralized merit based counseling conducted by National Board of Examinations as per prescribed guidelines.
- (ii) There shall be no interview or aptitude test at any stage and the allotment of seats will be purely on the basis of merit obtained in the CET.
- (iii) Applicants /their guardians are advised to exercise due caution and not to be allured by any claims of other mode of admission. They are advised to bring any such information to the notice of National Board of Examinations by e-mail mail@natboard.edu.in or fax 011-45593009/45593031.
- (iv) As per guidelines of NBE the accredited hospitals /institutions is strictly required to adhere to the admission criteria prescribed by NBE i.e. 10(i) & 10(ii), there is no management quota or any kind of preferential quota that has been permitted by NBE.
- (v) The accredited hospital /institutions are not required to take any caution money or deposit of original certificates from the candidates.
- (vi) Guidelines for conduct of Centralized Counseling shall be made available on NBE website www.natboard.edu.in at the time of conduct of counseling.
- (vii) Indicative list of seats available for July 2011 admission session can be seen at Serial No. 12 of this bulletin.
- (viii) Candidates successful in the CET will be asked to participate in the centralized counseling in order of their merit and will be able to opt for the NBE accredited institution/hospital/medical college of their choice as per availability at their merit position.
- (ix) Candidate can exercise choice of their specialty and institution at the time of counseling and can choose from the seats available at their merit position.
- (x) After getting registered with the Board for DNB training at any NBE accredited Institution/Hospital/Medical College for three years, candidate will be required to complete his/her DNB training forspecified period of time w.e.f. his/her date of registration with NBE as per applicable guidelines. Candidates will be required to comply with the leave guidelines of NBE.



- (xi) On completion of DNB training, candidates will have to qualify DNB final Examination conducted by NBE to be eligible for award of DNB degree.
- (xii) Candidates are advised to refer to NBE website <u>www.natboard.edu.in</u> for further details regarding DNB final Examination.

### 11. CENTRALIZED MERIT BASED COUNSELING – JULY 2012 ADMISSION SESSION

#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR COUNSELLING:**

- (I) Candidates who will qualify the Centralized Entrance Test conducted by NBE in August 2012 are eligible for admission to DNB courses in July 2012 admission session at various NBE accredited Medical Colleges/Institutions/Hospitals in India.
- (ii) Ineligibility if detected at any stage, NBE reserves its rights to withdraw admission to DNB course and to debar the candidate from taking any further examinations of NBE.

#### (iii) AVAILABILITY OF DNB SEATS:

A Provisional Seat matrix indicating DNB primary seats for allotment at various NBE accredited Medical colleges/Institutions/Hospitals is available on NBE website. The number of seats available is subject to decisions taken by National Board of Examinations from time to time. Final Seat matrix shall be published prior to the counseling.

#### (iv) SCHEDULE OF COUNSELLING:

The detailed schedule of CET CENTRALIZED COUNSELING – JULY 2012 admission session shall be displayed at the notice board of National Board of Examinations, Ansari Nagar, New Delhi & NBE website <a href="https://www.natboard.edu.in">www.natboard.edu.in</a>

#### (v) ALLOTMENT OF SEATS BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE:

- The allotment of seats shall be made to the eligible candidates <u>only</u> through personal appearance and they will be called in batches in the order of merit as per time schedule for 1st Round of Counseling.
- b The 'Time Schedule' and scheme for 2nd Round of counseling shall be hosted after completion of the 1st Round of Counseling. Candidate who could not attend the 1st round of counseling in person but has deposited the required fee before the prescribed cut off date i.e. commencement of 1st round of counseling shall be eligible to participate in the 2nd round of counseling.



- c Once the confirmed DNB seat has been opted, the candidate can not participate in the next round of counseling irrespective of the joining status of the candidate i.e. whether he/she has joined the allotted seat or not.
- d The counseling shall be done on the basis of the Overall Rank. However, reserved seats will be allotted to concerned category candidates only. Candidates of reserved category can opt for either reserved seat earmarked for them or unreserved seat in order of their merit. Candidates may note that reservation status of DNB seats at a particular institution/medical college is provided by the respective institution only based on the roster maintained by the institution.
- e No separate intimation regarding counseling will be sent. Candidates are advised to refer to the NBE website periodically for update in this regard.
- (vi) Candidates will be required to bring their RANK LETTER at the time of counseling along with the prescribed documents. Rank letters shall be available on NBE website after the merit list is published.
- (vii) **COUNSELING FEE**: Candidates will be required to deposit a counseling fee of Rs. 2000/- through demand draft in favour of National Board of Examinations, payable at New Delhi, on the day of counseling at counseling venue itself.
- (viii) Candidate will have to be present in person on the day of his/her counseling to claim the seat at scheduled time specified in his/her Rank Letter. Candidate may kindly ensure to arrive for counselling on time at designated venue. NBE shall not be responsible for delay in arrival due to any reason. Candidate shall not be permitted to enter counselling venue if his/her batch has already been admitted for counselling at designated time. No claim in this regards will be entertained. NBE reserves its rights to take appropriate decisions in cases of late reporting and participation in counseling through authorised representative.
- (ix) Candidates have to bring the following documents **IN ORIGINAL**, along with certified copies of the documents at S.No. (ii) to (ix), for participation in counselling:
- a. Rank Letter downloaded from NBE website www.natboard.edu.in
- b. CET PASS certificate issued by NBE of session based on PASS result of which DNB seat is to be opted in Jan 2012 counselling.
- c. MBBS Degree/Provisional passing certificate.
- d. Internship Completion Certificate.
- e. Permanent Registration certificate issued by MCI/State Medical Council for registration of MBBS qualification.



- f. Matriculation/High School/Higher Secondary Certificate as a proof of Date of Birth.
- g. SC/ST/PWD certificate issued by competent authority, if applicable.
- h. OBC certificate issued by competent authority, if applicable. The sub-caste should tally with the central list of OBC.
- I. Any other relevant certificate or document.
- (x) Candidates without original documents will not be allowed to appear/participate in Centralized Counselling by NBE under any circumstances. Candidates who have deposited their original documents with the Institutes/Colleges/Universities and have come for counseling with a certificate stating that "their original certificates are deposited with the Institute/Colleges/University" will not be allowed to participate in counseling.
- (xi) Candidates will be required to bring one of the Govt issued ID card (PAN card or Indian Passport or Driving Licence or Election ID card or Aadhaar Card) in original at the time of appearing for counselling. No other ID proof will be accepted.
- (xii) All the certificates must be in HINDI or ENGLISH. In case if any of the certificate(s) is/are in regional language, its Hindi/English version translated copy duly authenticated by a Group 'A' Gazetted Officer will be required in original.
- (xiii) Seat Allotment letter will be issued to the candidate only on the same day of counseling.

#### (xiv) JOINING OF THE COURSE:

Immediately after joining DNB training, candidates are required to send to NBE a duly completed prescribed form July 2012 through Head of their institution for confirming their DNB seat.
- b. With one month of joining DNB training, candidates are required to furnish following documents to NBE to get registered with NBE for DNB course:
- Aduly completed application form for JULY 2012 admission session.
- A registration fee of Rs 5000 to be deposited through challan/Pay-in-slip at any branch of the Indian Bank across India.
- c. Contact details mentioned in registration form will be treated as final and any further correspondence will be sent only at these correspondence details in future.

#### II. PRACTICE TEST

- a. A practice test to provide candidates with the feel and functionality of the actual test will be made available on NBE website prior to the actual test window. Candidates are advised to go through the practice test carefully to familiarize themselves with the screens, layout and navigation.
- b. The practice test shall be made available to the candidates before the actual examination at NBE website.

#### III. REPORTING OF CANDIDATES TO THE CENTRE

- a. The candidates should arrive at the test centre at the reporting time mentioned in the admit card on the day of scheduled appointment. This will allow time for security checks, identity verification and checking in for examination.
- b. Candidates are required to bring their admit cards along with a valid and original Government issued identification card (only passport or voter card or pan card or Aadhaar Card will be acceptable) at the test site. Photocopies of original are not acceptable.
- c. Candidates without valid ID proof shall not be allowed to enter the examination premises.
- d. Candidates will not be allowed to take mobile phones, watches, food items, study material, lockets, bags, electronic gadgets or any other prohibited items inside the examination premises. To avoid any hardship candidates are advised not to bring such items along with them.

#### IV. SECURITY AT THE TEST CENTRE

#### **Getting to the Test Centre:**

- a. Maps and directions to each centre will be made available on NBE website. Candidates are required to plan their travel accordingly.
- b. Candidates are advised to see the location of the centre one day prior to the actual day of examination. Candidates have to reach the test centres at the reporting time. Candidates may note that late entry to the examination premises is not permitted under any circumstances. NBE shall not be responsible for delays in reaching the centre due to any reason.



- c. All candidates at the centre shall be frisked by security guards.
- d. Identity checks will be made upon arrival at the test centre to ensure that there are no unauthorized candidates appearing for the exam. Candidates are required to cooperate with the security checks.e. Please note that only the registered candidates will be allowed at the examination centre.
- e. Friends or relatives accompanying the candidates will not be allowed entry in the examination centre under any circumstances and will not be allowed to contact the candidate while the examination process is ongoing.
- f. All candidates are required to carry their admit card and a valid and original photo identification card along with them.
- g. Finger prints of all the candidates will be captured and candidates are requested to cooperate with this essential activity to avoid any cases of impersonation. This is a security feature which will also ensure that only the candidate who appeared for the exam is allowed to join an accredited institute for training.

#### V. TEST DAY PROCEDURES

- a. Once escorted to the designated computer terminal at the examination centre, a Test Centre Administrator (TCA) will check in the candidate.
- b. Candidates are required to keep their admit card and photo identification at all times during the conduct of examination.
- c. Pencils, eraser and rough paper will be distributed to each candidate.
- d. Candidates are required to listen to the TCA's instructions to begin the test.
- e. During the test, candidate may use the rough paper to do the rough work.
- f. Each workstation will be blocked on three sides front, left and right. Candidates are advised not to look around at other candidates as there will be surveillance cameras that record both audio and video.
- g. Any suspicious or disruptive behaviour on part of the candidate may lead to cancellation of candidature.



- h. For any issues during the test, candidate may raise his or her hand to notify TCA/Invigilator.
- I. In case of any disruption, rest assured that a registered candidate will get to test again within the testing/examination window.
- j. All rough paper must be returned to the TCA after the test. Any attempt to take the rough papers out of the test centre will be considered disruptive behaviour and liable for disqualification.

### 16. Centralised Entrance Test (CET) - July 2012

#### **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### I. Format of CET

#### a. Is there a new testing format for CET?

Yes, starting from the July 2012 administration, the Centralised Entrance Test (CET) will change from a paper and pencil test to a computer-based test (CBT). This is not an Internet-based test, i.e. a candidate does not take the test over the Internet. Instead of reading the questions from a paper booklet and darkening the ovals in an answer sheet, a candidate will now read the questions on a computer screen and choose an answer by using a mouse to click on the appropriate option.

# b. How is the computer-based format different from the paper and pencil format?

The only difference is in the way the questions are presented, and how responses are recorded.

#### c. What does a computer-based test look like?

A Practice Test will be made available on the NBE website www.natboard.edu.in to provide candidates with the look and feel, as well as functionality of the actual test.

#### II. Test Duration & Pattern

#### a. What is the duration of the test?

The test duration is 3 hours and will be conducted in a single section. There will also be an additional 15-minute tutorial prior to the start of the test. Candidates will also need to accept a non-disclosure agreement (NDA) before beginning the test.

#### b. How many questions will there be?

There will be a total of 180 questions.

#### c. What type of questions will there be?

The test will only contain multiple choice questions, each with four



(4) options and only one (1) correct response.

#### d. What will the test be based on?

The test will include all subjects taught during the MBBS course including pre-clinical, para-clinical and clinical. Approximate weightage will be given to each subject as indicated in the bulletin.

#### e. What is the 15-minute tutorial?

The tutorial provides a series of screens that will orient you to the computer-based CET. This will give you an opportunity to try the various features, including how to navigate between questions, review them, select, de-select, change and mark responses etc. The tutorial has a total duration of 15 minutes and candidates are advised to go through it entirely before starting the actual test. At the end of the tutorial, candidates will be asked to accept a non-disclosure agreement (NDA) before beginning the test. For a similar preview, candidates can take a tour of the Practice Test which will be available on NBE website at www.natboard.edu.in.

#### f. What is the Practice Test?

The Practice Test is a sample computer-based test that is intended to familiarise candidates with the navigation and functionality of the CET. It includes a tutorial on using the various features of the test like moving between screens, selecting, de-selecting, marking and reviewing responses etc., as well as some sample questions which will allow candidates to try out these features. Note that these sample questions are not representative of the content of difficulty level of the actual test.

#### III. Registration & Scheduling

#### a. When will the next CET be conducted?

The next CET will be conducted between 9th and 17th August 2012. There will be a total of 6 testing days within this testing window, with 2 testing sessions a day.

#### b. What are the timings for the testing sessions?

There will be 2 sessions - one at 10 AM and another at 3:15 PM.

#### c. Where will the test be conducted?



The test will be conducted at selected test centres in Ahmedabad, Bangalore, Chandigarh, Chennai, Delhi (NCR), Hyderabad, Kolkata, Mumbai, Nagpur, Pune and Trivandrum.

# d. Will I be able to select my preferred date, time and location for the test?

Candidates will be allowed to choose 3 cities in order of preference during the online application. NBE will allocate the actual date, time and location to each candidate based on availability.

#### e. How do I apply for the test?

Candidates may apply online via http://natboard.edu.in. An acknowledgement will be provided for all successful submissions. Along with this acknowledgement, candidates are also required to furnish self-attested / certified photocopies of MBBS degree / Provisional Pass certificate, Permanent / Provisional Registration certificate issued by Medical Council of India / State Medical Council for registration of MBBS qualification, NBE pay-in slip and original challan duly stamped by Bank as receipt of payment. These should be sent by post to the Executive Director, National Board of Examinations at Mahatma Gandhi Marg, Ansari Nagar, New Delhi-110029.

#### f. What is the test fee?

The fee for the CET is Rs. 3500 and the application fee is Rs. 750.

#### g. How do I pay for the test?

Candidates are required to fill in the specialised pay-in slip available on the NBE website www.natboard.edu.in and bring this to any of the Indian Bank or Axis Bank branches to obtain a pre-paid challan through cash deposit. Note that banks are permitted to levy transaction charges (Indian Bank: Rs. 30 per challan / Axis Bank: Rs. 70 per challan).

#### h. What is the last day for application?

The online application closes on 18th June 2012 at 6pm IST.?

#### I. What happens after I've submitted my online application?

After the successful submission of the online application for CET, candidates will receive an Admit Card via post. Candidates are advised



to log on to the NBE website www.natboard.edu.in to download and print a copy of their Admit Card to avoid any non-receipt or delays by post. The Admit Card will specify the confirmation number (roll number) of the candidate, test date, time and location. Candidates are required to appear for the test at the specified test centre, on the date and time indicated on the Admit Card.

#### j. Will I be allowed to change my test date, time or location?

No changes will be allowed. Your assigned appointment details will be provided in the Admit Card.

#### IV Rescheduling & Cancellation

#### a. Can I reschedule my test date / time?

No, NBE will allocate your test date, time and location based on availability. No changes will be allowed.

#### b. Can I cancel the test?

No, under no circumstances will a cancellation / refund be allowed.

#### c. If I do not take my test, will I be eligible for a refund?

No, your fees will not be refunded in case you do not appear for your test as per your scheduled location, date and time.

#### V. <u>Testing Day</u>

#### a. What is the reporting time for the test?

Candidates must arrive at their assigned test centre one (1) hour before their scheduled test start time. If the test begins at 10 AM, you must reach the test centre no later than 9 AM. If the test begins at 3:15 PM, you must reach the test centre no later than 2:15 PM. This will allow for security checks, identity verification and check-in. The test centre gates will close 30 minutes prior to the test start time. Candidates who arrive late will not be allowed to test.

#### b. What do I need to bring to the test centre?

Candidates are required to bring a printed copy of their Admit Card along with one of the following valid and original government-issued identification card (ID):



- Passport or
- Voter card or
- Pan card or
- Aadhaar Card

In case the candidates does not posses any of these above mentioned ID Cards he/she may contact NBE office atleast 2 weeks prior to the commencement of exam.

Photocopies of the ID are not acceptable. Candidates without a valid ID proof **will not be allowed** to enter the test centre.

Note: You will not be allowed to take personal items such as mobile phones, watches, food items, study material, lockets, bags, electronic gadgets or any other prohibited items into the testing room. You are advised not to bring these to the test centre.

c. Does the name appearing on the photo identification need to match the one shown on the Admit Card?

The name on your photo identification must match your name as shown on your Admit Card. If your name has been changed due to events such as marriage, you must show the relevant document mentioned below and submit a photocopy at the time of the test, interview and at the time of joining a programme:

- Marriage Certificate
- Divorce Decree
- Legal Name Change Document

#### d. Where can I find directions for getting to my test centre?

Maps and directions to each test centre will be available on the NBE website. Candidates are advised to plan their travel accordingly and make allowance for traffic and other unforeseen circumstances.

e. What happens during the security checks, identity verification and check-in?

Candidates will need to produce their Admit Card and one valid and



original ID for verification upon arrival at the test centre. Only registered candidates will be allowed into the test centre. Candidates will be frisked before entering the testing room to ensure they are not carrying any prohibited items. A digital photo and fingerprint of all candidates will also be captured electronically as part of the check-in process.

#### f. Will there be any breaks during the test?

No, there will be no scheduled breaks during the test but candidates are allowed to go to the restroom by raising their hand to inform the test centre administrator. Note that the on-screen timer will continue running during restroom breaks

#### g. What will I be provided with during the test?

At the test centre, each candidate will be seated at a desk with a computer terminal and he/she will be provided with pencils, eraser and rough/scratch paper for calculations. Rough work cannot be done on any other paper/sheet, as no other material will be allowed inside the testing room. On completion of the test, candidates will have to hand all the scratch paper and stationery back to the test centre administrator.

#### h. How do I know when the test time has ended?

There will be an on-screen timer on the top right corner of your screen which will count down from 3 hours. Candidates are advised to check this timer regularly and allocate their time carefully. A pop-up window will appear before the test ends to alert candidates.

# i. Will I be able to leave early if I finish the test before the allocated test time has ended?

No, candidates will not be allowed to leave until the entire duration of the test is up with the exception of genuine medical conditions.
