

Expression of Interest for subscription of e-Journals and e-Books in various Medical Specialties in Online Mode (2nd Call)

आयुर्विज्ञान में राष्ट्रीय परीक्षा बोर्ड (एनबीईएमएस), स्वास्थ्य और परिवार कल्याण मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार का एक स्वायत्त निकाय है, जिसे आधुनिक चिकित्सा के क्षेत्र में स्नातकोत्तर स्तर पर एक समान और उच्च स्तरीय परीक्षा आयोजित करने का कार्य सौंपा गया है। The National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS) is an autonomous body of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MOHFW), Govt. of India, entrusted with the task of conducting uniform and high standard exams at Post Graduation level in the field of Modern Medicine.

- 2. NBEMS invites Expression of Interest (hereinafter referred as the 'EOI/Stage-1') from eligible and qualified Aggregators of e-journals database, Publishers of e-books (both textbooks and reference) for NBEMS e-Library Project. Interested Aggregators / Publishers should provide sufficient and relevant information demonstrating that they meet the specified eligibility criteria and have the required qualifications to perform the Services. This Expression of Interest Document details the process of such shortlisting. As part of this procurement process, at Stage-2, the Request for Proposal (RFP) for selecting 'Successful Bidder' shall be subsequently released, which shall be issued only to the bidders shortlisted in Stage-1.

A. Objectives and Scope of the Requirements

- 1. The NBEMS is intending to setup a **Medical e-library**. Accordingly, Expression of Interest (EoI) is invited from the Aggregators of e-journals database / Publishers of e-books (both textbooks and reference) along with the details of e-resources, platform, etc. that the bidders can offer to the NBEMS for successful implementation of the said project.
- 2. The bidder shall provide e-Textbooks on subscription/one-time purchase/perpetual access and e-Journals on yearly subscription basis under NBEMS e-library project.
- 3. The list of specialties in which Medical E-Text books/E-Journals are required is mentioned as below:

5. Terms & Conditions

- i). The quotes should be for 12 months in case of e-journals aggregator database, in case e-books licensing can be for 12 month, perpetual access or one-time purchase.
- ii). The Committee will decide licensing model and resource (Books, e-journals, learning materials etc.) relevant to the field/ users:
 - a) In case of Point-of-care products, content access details may be furnished.
- iii). Aggregated embargo products will be considered based on number of peer reviewed journals covered in the database:
 - a) Should avoid predatory journals.
 - b) OA journals are not to be counted in the number of journals in the bundle.
- iv). Mode/method of trainings to all users has to be specified supported by good tutorial materials.
- v). Rights for Inter-Library-Loan (online delivery), permission to walk-in users, text/data mining for research purpose, downloading rights by

end-users, rights to maintain the downloaded content in a personal library management system, etc. should to be Provided in the license agreement.

- vi). Cancellation terms and post cancellation responsibilities of the Aggregators/Publishers such as payments/refunds if any (either side), usage rights and platform fee for using purchased (perpetual access) content should be clearly specified.
- vii). All Aggregators/Publishers have to adhere to the applicable Indian taxes, if any.
- viii). Jurisdiction and applicable law shall be India. Arbitration terms is applied as per Indian arbitration law.
 - ix). Terms and Conditions mentioned in this of tender form supersedes/override the terms and condition of Aggregators/Publishers' license agreement.
 - x). Tools, technology and content products has to specify transfer of contents/technology (without interrupting service) in case of discontinuation.



B. Eligibility Criteria / Pre-requisites

The bids of only those firms will be considered which satisfy the following eligibility criteria:

- i). The bidder should be publishers of the respective e-book and proprietor of aggregated database in case e-journals
- ii). Bidder to submit copy of the firm's / agency's PAN, GST Certificate.
- iii). Bidder should not be black listed by any Government departments, PSUs or any other organization in respect of any assignment or behavior. A certificate in this regard required to be submitted as per format at **Annexure III**.
- iv). The bidder should provide list of organization where bidder has provided services or at present providing services. Supporting documents to be attached.
- v). **Bidder should have an average annual turnover of Rs. 1 Crore.** Copy of Income Tax Return, Balance Sheets and P&L Statement for the last 3 year to be attached.
- vi). Bidders seeking exemption in experience / turnover being an MSE, must attach Udyog Aadhaar / relevant proof alongwith their bids.
- vii). The Aggregator/Publisher should have permission from Reserve Bank of India, permitting the Aggregator/Publisher to deal with the foreign journal subscription.
- viii). The aggregators should provide documentary evidence that aggregator has been permitted /authorized by the publisher to provide e-journals indicating the embargo period along with technical bid.



C. Instructions to the Bidders

1. Submission of offers

The Bidder shall submit their proposals as mentioned below:

- i). The tender type is Expression of Interest (EOI) under Two Stage Bidding. At Stage-1, the proposals should contain all the relevant information and desired enclosures in the prescribed format [Form I (A) and Form I (B)] along with the synopsis document/implementation plan and other documents the bidder feels necessary.
- ii). All information called for in the enclosed forms should be furnished against the respective columns in the forms. If information is furnished in a separate document, reference to the same should be given against respective columns in such cases. If any particular query is not applicable, it should be stated as '**Not Applicable**'. However, the bidders are cautioned that not giving complete information called for in the tender forms or not giving it in clear terms or making any change in the prescribed forms or deliberately suppressing the information may result in the bidder being summarily disqualified.
- iii). The Tenders should preferably be typewritten. There should not be any overwriting, cutting, or interpolation. The name and signature of bidder's authorized person should be recorded on each page of the application. All pages of the Tender Document shall be numbered and submitted as a package along with forwarding letter on agency's letterhead.
- iv). References, information and certificates from the respective clients certifying technical, delivery and execution capability of the bidder should be signed and the contact numbers of all such clients should be mentioned. The NBEMS may also independently seek information regarding the performance from the clients.
 - v). The bidder is advised to attach any additional information, which he/she thinks is necessary in regard to his/her capabilities to establish that the bidder is capable in all respects to successfully complete the envisaged work. The Bidder is however, advised not to attach superfluous information. No further information will be entertained after Tender Document is submitted, unless the NBEMS calls for it.
- vi). **Incorrect or misleading information**: If the bidder deliberately gives incorrect or misleading information in their tender or wrongfully creates circumstances for the acceptance of the tender, NBEMS reserves the right to reject such a tender at any stage and appropriate administrative action would be taken by NBEMS.
- vii). Even though agency may satisfy the qualifying criteria, it is liable to disqualification if it has record of poor performance or not able to understand the scope of work etc.

- viii). This Tender Document can be downloaded from NBEMS's web site (www.natboard.edu.in) or Central Public Procurement Portal (https://eprocure.gov.in/ and be submitted 'offline'.
 - ix). The proposals should be kept in sealed envelope super scribing "Expression of Interest (EOI) for subscription of e-Journals and e-Books in various Medical Specialties in Online Mode (2nd Call)" so as to reach The Hony. Executive Director, National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences, NAMS Building, Ansari Nagar, New Delhi 110029 before 02/02/2024:12 noon (Last Date). Late tenders shall not be accepted. The bids shall be opened as per schedule mentioned above, in presence of bidders who may like to be present.
 - x). Apart from the original proposal to be submitted in the manner detailed above, no copies should be sent to any other office of NBEMS. Such proposals will not be valid. Proposals not submitted in the standard formats given in this Tender Document will be summarily rejected. NBEMS shall not be responsible for any postal delay or non-receipt / non-delivery / incomplete Bid documents. No further correspondence on this will be entertained.
 - xi). Bidders are neither allowed to join hands to participate in the tender nor allowed to submit multiple bids. Bidding by the firms having common partners will be treated as multiple bids. In case of detection of such, their bid(s) is/are liable to be rejected.
- xii). NBEMS reserves right to award the work/cancel the award without assigning any reason. In case of differences, if any, the decision of the NBEMS shall be final.

2. Procedure for two Stage Bidding:

- i). In the first stage of the bidding process, the Procuring Entity invites EoI bids containing the broad objectives, technical and financial eligibility criteria, terms and conditions of the proposed procurement etc **without a bid price**.
- ii). On receipt of the Expressions of Interest, technical discussions/ presentations shall be held with the short-listed Aggregators/Publishers, which are prima facie considered technically and financially compliant.
- iii). During these technical discussions stage the NBEMS may also add those other stakeholders in the discussions who could add value to the decision making on the various technical aspects and evaluation criteria.
- iv). Based on the discussions/presentations so held, one or more acceptable solution could be decided upon laying down detailed technical specifications for each acceptable solution proposed by the Aggregators/Publishers, which meeting the objectives.

- v). In the second stage of the bidding process, the NBEMS will invite bids from all those bidders whose bids at the first stage were not rejected, to present <u>final bid with bid prices</u> in response to a revised set of terms and conditions of the procurement.
- vi). Any bidder, invited to bid but not in a position to supply the subject matter of procurement due to modification in the specifications or terms & conditions, may withdraw from the bidding proceedings without forfeiting any bid security that he may have been required to provide or being penalized in any way, by declaring his intention to withdraw from the procurement proceedings with adequate justification;
- vii). **At Stage-2**, Request for Proposals (RFP) for selecting Aggregator/Publisher, shall be issued to the bidders shortlisted at Stage-1 (EOI).

3. Earnest Money Deposit / Security Deposit

- a) All Bids must be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh) in the form of Demand Draft issued by any scheduled/nationalized bank drawn in favour of 'National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences'.
- b) Bidder shall be required to furnish a Performance Security Deposit @ 5% of the awarded value as per the Guidelines of the Govt. of India for duration of Contract Period plus 60 days, which shall be returned to the bidder on successful execution of the contract. No interest shall be payable on Performance Security Deposit.

4. Acceptance of Offer / Proposal

- a) NBEMS reserves the right to accept any bid under this tender in full or in part, or to reject any bid or all bids without assigning any reason.
- b) NBEMS reserves right for selection of e-books/e-journals out of the proposals received based on recommendation of the NBEMS e-library Committee.

D. Period of Contract

The duration of online subscription will be for one year.

E. Payment Terms

The payment shall be made against the services provided by firm, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- i). The **payment** shall be made after successful delivery of the goods /services to NBEMS, in accordance with the quotations submitted by the selected bidder and rates accepted by NBEMS.
- ii). The payment shall be released to the bidder at completion of each quarter.

- iii). No request for extra payment on account of increase in price on whatever account will be entertained.
- iv). The price offered by the bidders will be inclusive of all expenses/cost.
- v). TDS will be deducted at applicable rates.
- vi). NBEMS reserves the right to deduct amount from the bill raised by the firm as may be considered reasonable for unsatisfactory services or delay in providing of services. The decision of NBEMS will be the final in this regard.

F. General clauses

a) Penalty Clause / Liquidated Damage

- Delay or downtime of access to online resources on part of the Bidder in the performance of its delivery obligations shall render the Bidder liable to the imposition of penalty unless an extension of time is agreed upon and cancellation of contract.
- ii). If the delay adversely affects NBEMS in any way, the security deposit/ performance security will be forfeited and other legal action would be initiated as per terms and conditions of contract. The NBEMS may rescind this part of the contract and shall be free to get it done from any other agency at the risk and cost of Bidder.

b) Termination Clause

i). NBEMS reserves right to terminate the contract by serving 'One' Month notice to the Service Provider without assigning any reason.

c) Integrity Pact

The Bidder should be willing to enter into an integrity pact with the NBEMS, not to resort to any corrupt practices in any aspect/stage of the contract. The Bidder should commit itself to the promise:

- i). Not to offer any benefit to the employees of NBEMS;
- ii). Not to enter into any undisclosed agreement or understanding with other bidders with respect to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts; etc.
- iii). To disclose the name and address of agents and representatives in India and Indian Bidder to disclose its foreign principals or associates;
- iv). To disclose any past transgressions committed over the specified period with any other company in India or Abroad that may impinge on the anti-corruption principle;

Integrity Pact lays down the punitive actions for any violation.

d) Confidentiality

i). The Bidder and their personnel shall not, either during implementation or after completion of the project, disclose any proprietary or confidential information relating to the services, agreement or the NBEMS's business or operations. The legal liability for breach of confidentiality by the bidder and its employees solely lies with the bidder.

e) Resolution of Disputes

- i). The NBEMS and the Bidder shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation, any disagreement or dispute that may arise between them under or in connection with the Contract.
- ii). If, after 15 days from the commencement of such informal negotiations, the NBEMS and the Bidder are unable to resolve, amicably a contract dispute, either party may require that the dispute be referred for resolution to the formal mechanism in all matters and disputes arising there under, the sole arbitrator shall be mutually agreed upon by the parties in writing, who shall decide the claim and its decision shall be final and binding on both the parties.
- iii). However, during the period of doubt, disagreement or dispute, both the Bidder and the NBEMS shall ensure that the Project/contract continue in a normal way. Such doubts, disputes and disagreement shall not give any reason or freedom to either the NBEMS or the Bidder to interfere in or prevent normal functioning of the Project.

f) Legal Jurisdiction

All legal disputes between the parties shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts situated in New Delhi (India) only.
