Subject: Result of GPAT 2026 Declared

1. Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test (GPAT) 2026 was conducted by NBEMS on a computer-based platform across the country on **7th March 2026**.
2. As per qualifying criteria mentioned under clause 10.8 of the information bulletin of GPAT 2026 and duly approved by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), a candidate has been declared as QUALIFIED for admission to Master of Pharmacy Courses/award of scholarship for M. Pharm Courses/PhD courses provided that:
 - He/she has scored at least the minimum qualifying score/percentile in GPAT 2026 as mentioned below for respective category:

S. No	Category	Minimum Qualifying Criteria
1.	General/ EWS	50 th Percentile
2.	OBC/ SC/ ST	45 th Percentile
3.	PwBD (irrespective of their categories)	45 th Percentile

- He/she falls within 10% of the total appeared candidates (i.e. 5362 out of 53617 appeared), in order of GPAT 2026 merit, as per applicable reservation policies for EWS, OBC, SC, ST and PwBD candidates.

4. **GPAT-2026 Rank:** This is the overall merit position of the candidate amongst all the candidates who have appeared in GPAT-2026. In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal score in GPAT-2026, the inter-se-merit of such candidates has been determined as per para 10.8.6 of the Information Bulletin of GPAT-2026.
5. **Final answer keys of GPAT-2026** have been prepared based on the inputs of the subject matter experts after examining all the challenges/objections raised by the candidates to the provisional answer keys/recorded responses of GPAT 2026 as published by NBEMS on 13.03.2026. Candidates who had appeared in GPAT 2026 shall be able to access the post-challenge question paper along with the final answer keys on/after **15th April 2026** at NBEMS website <https://natboard.edu.in> through applicant login.

6. As per inputs of the experts, 7 questions asked in GPAT 2026 were found to be technically incorrect. Full marks have been awarded to all the appeared candidates (treated as correct responses) whether they have attempted these 7 questions or not. Answer key to 04 question has been corrected. Details of these questions are tabulated below:

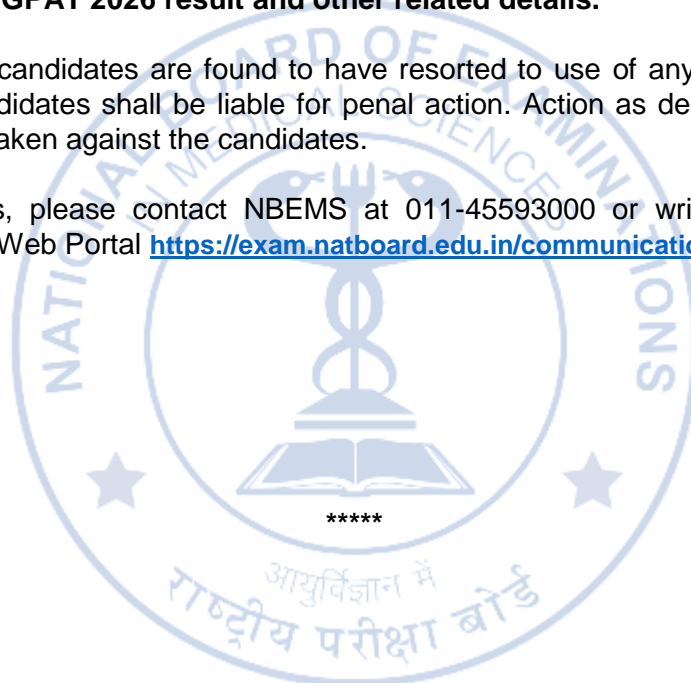

9. **Scorecard for GPAT-2026** mentioning the GPAT-2026 cut-off scores/percentile/rank will be available to download from the NBEMS website <https://natboard.edu.in> on/after **15th April 2026**. **Score cards shall be available to download on NBEMS website only for a period of SIX months after upload**. All applicants are advised to download their score cards within this window. Request to provide score card after the expiry of this window shall be summarily rejected. NBEMS does not provide score cards over email/ through post to individual candidates.
10. **Validity:** The validity of the GPAT-2026 score shall be for three years.
11. Appearance in GPAT-2026 does not confer any automatic rights to secure a M. Pharm seat and/or award of scholarship for M. Pharm Courses.
12. NBEMS has no role whatsoever in conduct of counseling and/or disbursement of scholarship. Verification of documents and eligibility determination of the candidates shall be undertaken at the time of counseling/admission process by concerned authorities. Result of GPAT 2026 is being shared with the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI). **Institutions participating in admissions to M. Pharm/PhD courses utilizing GPAT score may contact PCI for GPAT 2026 result and other related details.**
13. If at any stage, candidates are found to have resorted to use of any unfair means in the exam, such candidates shall be liable for penal action. Action as deemed appropriate by NBEMS will be taken against the candidates.
